La Paz County Ordinance NO.2019-01 Section 5.1;

Any dog three (3) months of age kept, harbored or maintained within La Paz County for (30) consecutive days or more must be licensed.

Spay/Neuter Certificate required for sterilized fee;

If your dog has been spayed or neutered, a certificate from a Veterinarian is required. You will be required to pay the unsterilized fee if you have no certificate.

Please attach your dog's rabies vaccination certificate to the license application.

Incomplete and/or applications without required certificates (rabies vaccination and spay/neuter for sterilized fee) will be returned.

Senior and Veteran Discount.

Seniors and Veterans receive a discount of \$5.00 dollars for each license. This discount applies to altered dogs only and to a maximum of 5 licenses. Verification is required that the owner is a Senior of 65 years of age or a Veteran of the United States Armed Forces.

The license tag issued to a dog will be updated every time the dog owner renews the license or applies for a new dog license. Department Management will mail dog license(s) to you after processing your application. Please allow 1-3 weeks for processing.
